





Tasha and Gary Garfield: California Label Products' Dream Team

When Tasha Garfield writes the story of California Label Products, the company she and husband Gary started 16 years ago, she uses a lot of exclamation points. And well she should—CLP, with the help of partner California Supply, has grown into a comprehensive and diversified label company with products both artistic and practical, every type of woven and printed label and hangtag, shipping labels, price tickets, care labels, plus printers, ribbons, and a service bureau and "an in-house art department!" proudly notes Tasha, the in-house art director. The duo's blended family includes Gary's son Justin, who has followed his father into the business, and Tasha's daughter Ashley, who sells airtime for Fox television. It all began with a look across a crowded classroom. "The rest," Tasha says, "is history!"

You guys met in a fashion illustration class, right? There was something about your smile, Tasha?

T.G.: There was definitely a smile involved. I thought Gary was checking me out.

G.G.: Basically, yeah. There was this cute girl in my class, and every time I looked at her she smiled at me. I went home and told my best friend that I had met a girl and I felt that something special was going to happen.

Why the class?

G.G.: At the time I was selling corrugated boxes. I was also a diehard skier. I had this hidden passion that I would design ski clothes. I needed to know how to express my ideas. I wanted to combine my practical side with my emotional side.

T.G.: I started a children's clothing line Lambykins, when my daughter was a baby. The company began with handpainted garments. I needed to take this class to expand the business and sell to larger retailers. There we were at UCLA, Gary at one end of the room and me at the other.

And you smiled.

T.G.: I was in my own world when I looked at him and I got a very warm feeling! Then I smiled and that smile changed my whole life. Little did I know what would happen next....

How did you end up working together?

G.G: While I was selling boxes, working with my ex-father-in-law, the computerized care-label industry started to happen. Using a Pellon-type perforated material and dot-matrix printers, manufacturers could print their own care labels in-house on demand. It changed the whole production process. I was asked by my box accounts if I could provide them with this product, which I was able to do. This was around the late '70s, early '80s. Then Tasha and I met in 1983.

T.G.: He was a little overwhelmed doing his boxes and labels. We were dating, and Gary asked if I would help him out. I said I would think about it. There was nothing really creative in there for me. But it was perfect timing. My clothing company had hit its peak and we were having some trouble. I began working on the computer, doing invoicing, which was the wrong side of my brain. Finally, we had a client who needed a new label designed. They loved my artwork, and I was hooked. I immediately took classes to learn how to do computer graphics and went to UCLA to get my degree in Graphic Design & VIsual Communications.

Kudos on this exceptional dating move, Gary.

T.G.: You think? But it wasn't a good relationship at the beginning. He was used to being the boss, but I was also my own boss. G.G.: I was a one-man band. I wasn't

used to having someone there to share responsibilities.

T.G.: He'd call and start telling me things I needed to do. I'd say, what's the matter, you can't say hi? No time to be courting any more.

So it was a rocky road working together at first. How's it going now?

G.G: I try to stay out of Tasha's world. Tasha pretty much handles the woven labels and hangtags, and I handle the industrial side, shipping labels, thermal printers, ribbons, price tickets.

T.G.: And I don't get involved in his world. Since the beginning, Gary's passion has been about the business; my passion is about the art. If it has a picture on it, it's part of the art department. My only negotiation with Gary at first was that I had to have an art department, and I had to be the art director.

G.G: It turns out, our art department is one of our best revenue-generating assets.

Sounds like you two have some good advice to impart to working couples.

T.G.: The advice is to find your niche and become independent in it, and appreciate the other person as much as you can.

G.G: Try not to invade the other person's world as much as possible. We had to learn to listen to one another. When we take the time to bounce ideas off each other, it generally

What surprises you most about the business vou two have created?

T.G.: That we are both good at what we do. G.G: It has enabled us both to be who we are and provide us with a very good,

at New Facility With 'Jumbo' Line

Lenzing, the Austrian maker of Tencel fibers, is on track to meet its planned production target of 30,000 tons of Tencel fiber at its new production facility at the Lenzing headquarters in Austria.

The company has been ramping up production at the new facility, which will be the largest Tencel production plant in the world.

"We are more than satisfied with the progression of the start-up curve. Based on the production process in the past days and weeks, we have reasonable grounds to believe that this latest generation of Tencel technology will completely fulfill our expectations," said Lenzing Chief Executive Officer Peter Untersperger in a statement.

The new facility will join Lenzing's three existing plants in Austria, Great Britain and in the U.S. in Mobile, Ala. The new plant will include a "jumbo" production line with an annual nominal capacity of 67,000 tons.

Once fully operational, the new facility will increase total Tencel production capacity for the Lenzing Group from 155,000 tons annually to about 220,000

"The successful start-up of production operations is a technological milestone for Tencel and for the entire

Lenzing Group," said Lenzing Chief Operating Officer Friedrich Weninger. "This new Tencel facility is decisive to ensure the longterm viability of fiber production at the Lenzing site and the basis for future investments in all markets."—A.A.N.

Apple, Macy's Debut Digital Wallets

To great fanfare, **Apple** introduced its digital wallet, **Apple Pay**, on Sept. 9. However, more retailers are getting into the mobile payments market.

Last month Macy's Inc. introduced My Wallet, an app that will allow Macy's customers to organize their payment options when shopping at Macy's. It also will offer easy access to Macy's promotions and deals.

Digital-wallet technology took its first major public bow in 2011 when the **Google Wallet**, which was developed by **Google**, was introduced. It provided an online place for its users to store debit cards, credit cards, loyalty cards and gift cards as well as a place to redeem sales promotions on mobile phones.

It gained a lot of press attention, but the public did not embrace it, according to Greg Sterling, a frequent pundit on media and personal technology and vice president of strategy and insights for **Local Search Association**, a marketing trade association in the San Francisco Bay Area. However, there is a good chance that Apple Pay will succeed, Sterling wrote in a *Marketing Land* blog on Sept. 9.

People using Apple products and apps are already in heavy use among a wide array of consumers who navigate their day's tasks with their **iPhones** and **iPads**, so it wouldn't be a far leap for this big group of consumers to start using Apple Pay, Sterling contended. These consumers already pay for Apple goods with credit cards on **iTunes**. Also, Apple partnered with popular brands to accept Apple Pay. They include **Bloomingdale's**, **Macy's**, **Disney Store**, **McDonald's**, **Nike** and **Whole Foods**.

Recently introduced digital wallets also may have the benefit of riding on a cresting wave. More consumers are shopping through m-commerce on their smartphones and tablets. On May 13, **comScore Inc.**, which analyzes the e-commerce business, said that American consumers spent \$7.3 billion through m-commerce in the first quarter of 2014. It was a 23 percent increase compared with the same time in the previous year.

comScore also found that desktop e-commerce spending in the first quarter of 2014 increased 12 percent to \$56.1 billion in a yearover-year comparison.






